Lord & Benoit Post-Mortem of Small High-Tech Public Company Accentuates Need for Sarbanes-Oxley Compliance

The Tipping Point provides a sobering post-mortem case study of a small, high technology public company that, according to a well-informed financial insider, "could have been saved if it had been complying with Section 404." Based on published comments from President Barack Obama, Vice President Joseph Biden, PCAOB Chair Mark Olson, and SEC Chair Mary Shapiro, the mood appears to be changing from years of deadline delays to more robust insistence upon SOX compliance by smaller public companies in 2009.
